H-2556 FR 14 Respondent. 15 16 ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE 17 (Failure to Comply With Condition #5 of Stipulation and Agreement in Settlement and Order) 18 TO: AMBER JUNE SPECK ("Respondent"): 19 20 On January 4, 2012, a restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to 21 Respondent by the Department of Real Estate (herein the "Department") by Stipulation and 22 Agreement on the terms, conditions and restrictions set forth in the Order of the Real Estate 23 Commissioner (herein the "Commissioner"), effective January 4, 2012, in Case No. H-2556 FR. 24 The Commissioner's Order granted Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate 25 salesperson license subject to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the California Business and 26 Professions Code (herein the "Code"), and to enumerated additional terms, conditions and 27 restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of the Code. Among those terms and

conditions, the Commissioner's Order required Respondent to work in the same physical office space and location as her employing broker (herein "Condition #5") and provided that if Respondent failed to satisfy Condition #5, the Commissioner may order the suspension of the restricted license until Respondent presents such evidence showing that Condition #5 has been satisfied.

As of March 29, 2012, Respondent has failed to submit proof satisfactory to the Commissioner that she is working in the same physical office space and location as her employing broker. The Commissioner has determined that Respondent has failed to satisfy Condition #5, and as such, Orders Respondent's license be suspended until Respondent complies with Condition #5.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of Section 10156.7 of the Code, that Respondent's restricted real estate salesperson license and the exercise of any privileges thereunder is hereby suspended until such time as Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Commissioner of compliance with Condition #5 referred to above, or pending final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by the Department of Real Estate which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed self-addressed, stamped envelope:

HEARING RIGHTS: You have the right to a hearing to contest the Commissioner's determination that you are not in compliance with Condition #5. If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by

or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Department, Legal Section, at 2201 Broadway, P. O. Box 187007, Sacramento, California 95818-7007, within twenty (20) days after the date that this Order Suspending Restricted Real Estate License was mailed to or served on you, the Department will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
