16	ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE (Condition #7 of Stipulation and Agreement in Settlement and Order)
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18	TO: AMBER JUNE SPECK ("Respondent"):
19	On January 4, 2012, a restricted real estate salesperson license was issued by the
20 21	Department of Real Estate to Respondent on the terms, conditions and restrictions set forth in the Real Estate Commissioner's Decision effective January 4, 2012, in Case No. H-2556 FR.
22	This Decision granted the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license
23	subject to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions Code of the State
24	of California, and to enumerated additional terms, conditions and restrictions imposed under
25	authority of Section 10156.6 of said Code.
26	Among those terms and conditions, Condition #7 of the Decision required
27	Respondent to, within six (6) months from the issuance of the restricted license, take and pass
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the Professional Responsibility Examination (PRE) administered by the Department, including
 the payment of the appropriate examination fee, and if Respondent failed to satisfy this
 condition, the Commissioner was authorized to order the suspension of the restricted license
 until Respondent passed the examination.

As of August 6, 2012, the Commissioner determined that Respondent failed to
satisfy Condition #7, in that Respondent failed to take and pass the PRE; therefore, Respondent's
license may be suspended until Respondent satisfies Condition #7 by providing proof to the
Commissioner that Respondent has taken and passed the PRE.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of Section 10156.7 of the
Business and Professions Code of the State of California, that Respondent's restricted real estate
salesperson license and the exercise of any privileges thereunder is hereby suspended until such
time as Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Commissioner of compliance with the
condition referred to above, or pending final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing
Rights" set forth below).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards
issued by the Department of Real Estate which are still in the possession of Respondent be
immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed self-addressed,
stamped envelope:
