DECISION

This Decision is being issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 11520 of the Government Code, on evidence of compliance with Section 11505 of the Government Code and pursuant to the Order of Default filed on September 28, 2011, and the findings of fact set forth herein, which are based on one or more of the following: (1) Respondent's express admissions, (2) affidavits and (3) other evidence.

This Decision revokes a real estate license and/or license rights on grounds of the conviction of a crime pursuant to the Real Estate Law, Part I of Division 4, of the California Business and Professions Code ("the Code"), Sections 490 (conviction of crime) and 10177(b) (conviction of crime).

The right to reinstatement of a revoked real estate license is controlled by Section 11522 of the Government Code. A copy of Section 11522 and a copy of the Commissioner's Criteria of Rehabilitation are attached hereto for the information of Respondent.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1.

On August 9, 2011, Joseph Aiu made the Accusation in his official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California. The Accusation, Statement to Respondent, and Notice of Defense were mailed, by certified mail, return receipt requested, to Respondent's last known mailing address on file with the Department on August 18, 2011.

On September 28, 2011, no Notice of Defense having been received or filed herein within the time prescribed by Section 11506 of the Government Code, Respondent's default was entered herein.

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Respondent MYLENE FUNK ("Respondent") is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Code as a real estate salesperson.

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On or about May 20, 2011, in the United States District Court, Southern District of California, in Case No. 10CR2242JM, Respondent was convicted of four counts of violation of Section 1014, Title 18 of the United States Code (False Statement to Federally Insured Bank), felonies and crimes which bear a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, of the California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

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Cause of disciplinary action against Respondent MYLENE FUNK exists with reference to the acts and/or omissions set out in Paragraph 4, above, pursuant to Business and Professions Code Sections 490 and 10177(b).

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The standard of proof applied was clear and convincing proof to a reasonable certainty.

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of Section 1014, Title 18 of the United States Code (False Statement to Federally Insured Bank), felonies and crimes which bear a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, of the California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate The facts alleged in Paragraph 2, above, constitute cause under Sections 490 (Conviction of Crime) and 10177(b) (Conviction of Crime Substantially Related to Qualifications, Functions or Duties of Real Estate Licensee) of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law. WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code), and for such other and further JOSEPH AIU Deputy Real Estate Commissioner

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
