17	This Accusation amends the Accusation filed on July 28, 2016. The
18	Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, a Supervising Special Investigator of the State of California,
19	for cause of Accusation against JOHN BENJAMIN MURPHY and THREE FROGS, INC.
20	("Respondents"), is informed and alleges as follows:

22	The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, acting in her official capacity as a
23	Supervising Special Investigator of the State of California, makes this Accusation against
24	JOHN BENJAMIN MURPHY and THREE FROGS, INC.
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	First Amended Accusation of John Benjamin Murphy and Three Frogs, Inc.

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Respondent JOHN BENJAMIN MURPHY ("MURPHY") presently has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code ("Code"), as a real estate broker.

3.

Respondent THREE FROGS, INC. ("THREE FROGS"), presently has license rights under the Real Estate Law as a corporate real estate broker.

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

(CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

4.

On or about March 26, 2015, Respondents MURPHY and THREE FROGS pled guilty and were convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, Case No. SCD255289, for violation of California Unemployment Insurance Code Section 2117.5 (Acting With Intent To Evade Tax), a misdemeanor, and Labor Code Section 3700.5(a) (Failure To Secure The Payment Of Compensation), a misdemeanor.

Respondent MURPHY was placed on three years of summary probation, and ordered to serve one day in jail and pay restitution, fines and fees. Additionally, Respondent MURPHY was ordered to complete 14 days of the Public Service Program.

Respondent THREE FROGS was placed on three years of summary probation, and ordered to pay restitution, fines and fees.

5.

The convictions described in Paragraph 4 bear a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

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The crimes of which Respondents MURPHY and THREE FROGS were convicted, as described in Paragraph 4 above, constitute cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of all the licenses and license rights of Respondents MURPHY and THREE FROGS under the Real Estate Law.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

(FAILURE TO SUPERVISE)

7.

The conduct, acts, or omissions of Respondent MURPHY, as alleged above, is in violation of Code Section 10159.2, and subjects all his real estate licenses and license rights to suspension or revocation pursuant to Code Sections 10177(d), 10177(g) and/or 10177(h).

8.

Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau of Real Estate, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

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WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all the licenses and license rights of Respondents JOHN BENJAMIN MURPHY and THREE FROGS, INC. under the Real Estate Law, for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
