STATEMENT OF ISSUES

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16 The Complainant, TRICIA D. SOMMERS, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner
17 of the State of California, for Statement of Issues against GREGORY DANIEL BEHRMANN,
18 (Respondent), alleges as follows:

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20 Complainant makes this Statement of Issues in her official capacity.

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22 On or about January 4, 2011, Respondent made application to the Department of
23 Real Estate of the State of California (the Department) for a real estate salesperson license.

25 On or about February 17, 2006, in the Superior Court of the State of California,
26 County of Calaveras, Case No. C 11701, Respondent was convicted of a violating Section
27 148(a) of the California Penal Code (Resisting Arrest), a misdemeanor and a crime which bears

1 a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations, (the
2 Regulations), to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

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4 On or about June 9, 1995, in the United States District Court, Southern District
5 of Illinois, Case No. 3:94-cr-30091-WDS-1, Respondent was convicted of violating 21 USC
6 841(a) (1) (Transporting Narcotics), a felony and a crime which bears a substantial relationship
7 under Section 2910 of the Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate
8 licensee.

9 PRIOR ADMISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS



11 Effective April 19, 2009, in Case No. H-8235 SF, before the Department, the
12 Real Estate Commissioner denied Respondent's application for a real estate salesperson license.

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14 Respondent's criminal convictions, as described in Paragraph 3 and 4, above,
15 constitute cause for denial of his application for a real estate license under Sections 10177(b)
16 (Further Grounds for Disciplinary Action- Conviction of Crime) and 480(a) (Conviction of
17 Crime) of the Code.

18 WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for
19 hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
20 authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate salesperson license to
21 Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
