ORDER SUSPENDING REAL ESTATE LICENSE

(Section 10186.1 of the California Business and Professions Code)

TO: RONALD E. RUSSELL (Respondent):

On or about March 25, 2014, the California Bureau of Real Estate (Bureau) received a certified copy of the record of your conviction of a felony, and has confirmed that you are incarcerated as a result of your felony conviction(s).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under the authority of Section 10186.1 of the California Business and Professions Code (Code) that the real estate license heretofore issued to Respondent, and the exercise of any privileges, is hereby suspended automatically until such time as Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Commissioner that Respondent is no longer incarcerated, or pending final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below).

HEARING RIGHTS: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10186.1(d) of the Code, you have the right to a hearing to contest the automatic suspension imposed by the

1 Commissioner. If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may  
2 be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a  
3 written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the  
4 Bureau at:


