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COURT PAPER STATE OF CALIFORNIA STD. 113 (REV. 8-72)

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On or about August 16, 1990, in the Municipal Court of California, Santa Clara County, Respondent was convicted of a violation of Section 14610A of the California Vehicle Code, a crime involving moral turpitude and a crime which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations (Regulations) to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

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The crime of which Respondent was convicted and the acts done by Respondent, as alleged above, constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Sections 480(a) and/or 10177(b) of the Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
