On March 16, 2011, an Accusation was filed in this matter against Respondent MONIQUE DZUNG LE.

On September 1, 2011, Respondent petitioned the Commissioner to voluntarily surrender her real estate salesperson license pursuant to Section 10100.2 of the Business and Professions Code.

DECLARATION

My name is MONIZUE DZUNG LB, and I am currently licensed as a real estate salesperson and/or have license rights with respect to said license. I am representing myself in this matter.

In lieu of proceeding in this matter in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Sections 11400 et seq., of the Business and Professions Code), I wish to voluntarily surrender my real estate license(s) issued by the Department of Real Estate ("Department"), pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10100.2,

I understand that by so voluntarily surrendering my license(s), I may be relicensed as a broker or as a salesperson only by petitioning for reinstatement pursuant to Section



11522 of the Government Code. I also understand that by so voluntarily surrendering my license(s), I agree to the following:

- The filing of this Declaration shall be deemed as my petition for voluntary 1. surrender.
- 2. It shall also be deemed to be an understanding and agreement by me that I waive all rights I have to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations contained in the Accusation filed in this matter at a hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code Sections 11400 et seq.), and that I also waive other rights afforded to me in connection with the hearing such as the right to discovery, the right to present evidence in defense of the allegations in the Accusation and the right to cross-examine witnesses.
- 3. I further agree that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, all affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Department in this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance may be considered by the Department to be true and correct for the purpose of deciding whether to grant re-licensure or reinstatement pursuant to Government Code Section 11522.
- I freely and voluntarily surrender all my licenses and license rights under the Real Estate Law.

J. HABERER, II, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of 16 the State of California, for cause of Accusation against MONIQUE DZUNG LE, also known as 17 "Monique Le Nguyen", (Respondent), is informed and alleges as follows: 18 19 The Complainant makes this Accusation in his official capacity. 20 21 Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate 22 Law Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Codè (the Code) as a real estate 23 salesperson. 24 3 25 On or about December 3, 2010, in the United States District Court, Eastern 26 District of California, Case No. 1:07-dr-00316-LJO-6, Respondent was convicted of violating 27

18 USC 1341 and 18 USC 1349 (Conspiracy to Commit Mail Fraud), a felony and a crime which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of the Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

The facts alleged in Paragraph 3, above, constitute cause under Sections 490 (Conviction of Substantially Related Crime) and 10177(b) (Further Grounds for Disciplinary Action- Conviction of Crime) of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code), and for such other and further relief as may be proper under the provisions of law.
