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15	ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE
16	(Professional Responsibility Examination)
17	TO: EDWARD PY-JEN YUAN (Respondent):
18	On December 10, 2012, a restricted real estate salesperson license was issued by
19	the Bureau of Real Estate (Bureau) to Respondent on the terms, conditions and restrictions set
20	forth in the Real Estate Commissioner's (Commissioner) Order effective December 10, 2012, in Case No. H-11147 SF. This Order granted the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate
21	salesperson license subject to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions
22	Code (Code) of the State of California, and to enumerated additional terms, conditions and
23	restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of said Code. Among those terms,
25	conditions and restrictions, the Decision required Respondent, within six months after December
26	10, 2012, the effective date of the Order, take and pass the Professional Responsibility
27	Examination (PRE) administered by the Bureau, including the payment of the appropriate

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examination fee and provided that if Respondent failed to satisfy this condition, the
 Commissioner may order suspension of the restricted real estate salesperson license until
 Respondent passes the examination.

To date, Respondent has failed to submit proof satisfactory to the Commissioner
of successfully passing the above-ordered examination. The Commissioner has determined that
Respondent has failed to satisfy this condition, and as such, that Respondent's license may be
suspended until Respondent satisfies this condition.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED pursuant to the Order of December 10,
 2012, that Respondent's restricted real estate salesperson license and the exercise of any
 privileges thereunder be and hereby is suspended until such time as Respondent provides proof
 satisfactory to the Commissioner of compliance with the condition referred to above, or pending
 final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards
 issued by the Bureau of Real Estate which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately
 surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed self-addressed, stamped envelope:

If you desire a 21 hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in 22 writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by 23 or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Bureau of Real Estate, Legal Section, at 1651 24 Exposition Blvd, Sacramento, California 95815 or P. O. Box 137007, Sacramento, California 25 95813-7007, within twenty (20) days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on 26 you, the Bureau will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing. 27
