AMENDED ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

The Order Granting Reinstatement of License, filed on October 20, 2017 in Case No. H-29711 LA, is amended Nunc Pro Tunc, as follows:

On November 12, 2003, in Case No. H-29711 LA, a Decision was rendered revoking the real estate broker license of Respondent, but granting Respondent the right to apply for a restricted real estate salesperson license, effective December 4, 2003. Respondent was issued a restricted real estate salesperson license since December 4, 2003 and her license has remained restricted to date.

On November 16, 2016, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of a previously held real estate salesperson license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements

1 of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate salesperson license and that it  
2 would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for  
4 reinstatement is granted and that a real estate salesperson license be issued to Respondent if  
5 Respondent satisfies the following conditions within twelve (12) months from the date of this  
6 order:

7 1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate  
8 salesperson license within the 12 month period following the date of this Order; and

9 2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education  
10 requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education courses must be  
11 completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed  
12 application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.

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15 This Order shall become effective immediately.
