

ORDER TO DESIST AND REFRAIN

The Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California has caused an investigation to be made of your activities as a real estate broker, and based on the findings of that investigation is of the opinion that VALLEY PROPERTIES, and IRAJ MORSHEDIZADEH have violated Section 10145(a) of the Business and Professions Code (hereinafter Code) as well as Regulations 2731, 2831, 2831.1, 2831.2, 2832.1 and 2834 (all references herein to Regulations refer to the California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Chapter 6), and Financial Code Section 17600(a)(4).

That at all times herein mentioned, you, VALLEY
PROPERTIES, were licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the
State of California (hereinafter Department) as a corporate real

estate broker and you, IRAJ MORSHEDIZADEH, were licensed as the designated officer of said corporation.

II

At all times herein mentioned, you, VALLEY PROPERTIES, and IRAJ MORSHEDIZADEH, on behalf of others in expectation of compensation engaged in the business, acted in the capacity of, advertised or assumed to act as a real estate broker in the State of California within the meaning of Section 10131(a) of the Code, including soliciting buyers and sellers and negotiating the sale of real property.

III

During 2003, in connection with the aforesaid brokerage activities, you, VALLEY PROPERTIES, and IRAJ MORSHEDIZADEH, accepted or received funds from buyers and sellers and thereafter made disbursements of such funds. You maintained Trust Account No. 00-82333469, East West Bank, 1900 Avenue of the Stars, Los Angeles.

IV

In connection with your activities as a real estate broker, as described above, you, VALLEY PROPERTIES, and IRAJ MORSHEDIZADEH, acted in violation of the Real Estate Law as follows:

- (1) Violated Section 10145(a) of the Code and Regulation 2832.1 by maintaining as of September 30, 2003, a shortage in the trust account in the amount of \$4,004.35.
- (2) Violated Regulation 2831 in that the columnar record was not complete and accurate in that it was missing the

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date the funds were received from the buyers and a daily balance.

Not all earnest money deposits received from buyers and
not deposited in a trust account were recorded accurately.

- (3) Violated Regulation 2831.1 in that the separate records were not complete and accurate in that they were missing a daily balance. Not all receipts and disbursements were recorded accurately.
- (4) Violated Regulation 2831.2 by failing to maintain monthly reconciliations for the trust account that were accurate.
- (5) Violated Regulation 2834 in that the designated officer for the corporation was not a signatory on the trust account. Non-licensees were allowed to sign on the trust account without having fidelity bond coverage.
- (6) Violated Regulation 2731 by employing the unlicensed fictitious business name Valley Escrow in your real estate brokerage business.
- (7) Violated Section 17600(a)(4) of the Financial Code by performing escrows for transactions wherein you were not engaged in activities requiring a real estate license.

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NOW, THEREFORE, YOU, VALLEY PROPERTIES, AND IRAJ MORSHEDIZADEH, ARE ORDERED TO DESIST AND REFRAIN from performing any and all activities for which a real estate broker license is required until you comply with all provisions of the Real Estate Law as discussed in this Order.
