DECLARATION

My name is BARRY B. WEISS, and I am currently licensed as a real estate salesperson and/or have license rights with respect to said license. I am represented by Mary E. Work, Attorney at Law.

In lieu of proceeding in this matter in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Sections 11400 et seq., of the Government Code), I wish to voluntarily surrender my real estate license issued by the Department of Real Estate ("Department"), pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10100.2.

I understand that by so voluntarily surrendering my license, I may be relicensed as a broker or as a salesperson only by petitioning for reinstatement pursuant to Section 11522 of the Government Code. I also understand that by so voluntarily surrendering my license, I agree to the following:

- 1. The filing of this Declaration shall be deemed as my petition for voluntary surrender.
- 2. It shall also be deemed to be an understanding and agreement by me that I waive all rights I have to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations contained in the Accusation filed in this matter at a hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code Sections 11400 et seq.), and that I also waive other rights afforded to me in connection with the hearing such as the right to discovery, the right to present evidence in defense of the allegations in the Accusation and the right to cross-examine witnesses.

I further agree that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, all affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Department in this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance, and all allegations contained in the Accusation filed in the Department Case No. H-35279 LA, may be considered by the Department to be true and correct for the purpose of deciding whether to grant relicensure or reinstatement pursuant to Government Code Section 11522.

The Complainant, Maria Suarez, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of Accusation against BARRY B. WEISS, aka Barry Blaine Weiss ("Respondent"), is informed and alleges in her official capacity as follows:

At all times herein mentioned, Respondent was and is presently licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the State of California ("Department") as a real estate salesperson under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code ("Code").

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Pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 10153.3, Respondent was originally licensed as a salesperson with the Department on July 22, 1996.

CONVICTIONS

III

On or about March 6, 2007, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. 6BR04495, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Section 459 (burglary), a misdemeanor. Said crime involves moral turpitude and bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

IN AGGRAVATION

IV

On or about January 11, 2005, in the Superior of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. 4VN02597, as part of a plea agreement, Respondent pled nolo contendere to and was convicted of violating Vehicle Code Section 23103 (reckless driving/alcohol involved/no injury), a misdemeanor.

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On or about March 25, 1996, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. 95P10656, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Section 242 (battery), a misdemeanor.

VI

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Law.

The crime as alleged in Paragraph III above, of which Respondent was convicted, constitutes cause under Code Sections 490 and/or 10177(b) for the suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate

FAILURE TO DISCLOSE CONVICTION ON RENEWAL APPLICATION

VII '

On or about April 21, 2008, Respondent made application for renewal of his real estate salesperson license with the Department. In response to Question No. 3 on Respondent's salesperson renewal application, to wit: "WITHIN THE PAST FOUR YEAR PERIOD, HAVE YOU BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF LAW? CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.4 MUST BE DISCLOSED, HOWEVER, YOU MAY ONLY OMIT MINOR TRAFFIC CITATIONS WHICH DO NOT CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY OFFENSE", Respondent marked the answer box denoting "No", and failed to reveal the convictions described above in Paragraphs III and IV.

VIII

Respondent's failure to reveal the conviction against him as set forth in Paragraph III above, constitutes the procurement, or attempt to procure, a real estate license by fraud, misrepresentation or deceit, or by making a material misstatement of fact, knowing misrepresentation of a material fact, or by knowingly omitting to state a material fact, in his application, which constitutes cause under Code Sections 498

and/or 10177(a) for the suspension or revocation of Respondent's license and license rights of under the Real Estate Law. WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be

conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and, that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and/or license rights of Respondent, BARRY B. WEISS, under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
