17	ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE

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21	On May 4, 2012, a restricted real estate salesperson
22	license was issued by the Department of Real Estate
23	("Department") to JAROD LEE CHASE ("Respondent") on the terms,
24	conditions and restrictions set forth in the Real Estate
25	Commissioner's Decision in Case No. H-37146 LA. This Order,
26	which became effective on April 3, 2012, provided that the right
27	to a restricted real estate salesperson license was subject to
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the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and 1 Professions Code and to enumerated additional terms, conditions 2 and restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of 3 said Code ("Code"). Among those terms, conditions and 4 restrictions, Respondent was required to provide satisfactory 5 evidence that: (a) he has repaid \$5,750 to Elvia A. within six 6 (6) months from the effective date of the Decision; and (b) he 7 has since the most recent issuance of an original or renewal 8 real estate license, taken and successfully completed the 9 continuing education requirement of Article 2.5 of Chapter 3 of 10 the Real Estate Law for renewal of a real estate license, within 11 12 nine (9) months from the effective date of the Decision.

The Commissioner has determined that as of October 3, 2012, Respondent has failed to satisfy condition (a) and as of January 3, 2013, Respondent has also failed to satisfy condition (b) by failing to provide proof of completion of 30 hours in consumer service and consumer protection courses. As such, Respondent is in violation of Section 10177(k) of the Code.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of the Order issued in this matter that the real estate salesperson 20 license heretofore issued to Respondent and the exercise of any 21 privileges thereunder is hereby suspended until such time as 22 Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Department of 23 compliance with the "condition" referred to above, or pending 24 final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set 25 forth below). 26

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by Department which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed, self-addressed envelope to:

If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Department at 320 W. 4th Street, Room 350, Los Angeles, California 90013, within 20 days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on you, the Department will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing.
