17 The Complainant, Joseph Aiu, a Deputy Real Estate
18 Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of Accusation
19 against ROBERT ANDREW LEWALLEN ("Respondent") is informed and
20 alleges as follows:

22 The Complainant, Joseph Aiu, a Deputy Real Estate
23 Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation
24 in his official capacity.

25 2.

26 Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license
27 rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the

1 California Business and Professions Code ("Code"), as a real
2 estate broker.

3 3.

4 On or about June 23, 2011, in the Superior Court of
5 the State of California, County of Riverside, in Case No.
6 INF10002711, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted for
7 violation of Penal Code Section 236 (false imprisonment), a
8 misdemeanor. Respondent was sentenced to 36 months probation;
9 one day in jail; ordered to perform 30 hours of community
10 service; ordered to enroll in a 52-week domestic violence
11 program. In addition, Respondent was ordered to refrain from
12 annoying, harassing, threatening, or disturbing the peace of
13 victim.

16 This conviction, by its facts and circumstances, bears
17 a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter
18 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications,
19 functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

20 5.

21 The crime of which Respondent was convicted
22 constitutes cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code
23 for the suspension or revocation of the license and license
24 rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

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
