(CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

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On or about April 20, 2012, in the Superior Court of California, County of Orange, in Case No. 10CF0477, Respondent was convicted of violating 12 counts of Penal Code Section 182(a)(1)(Conspiracy to Commit a Crime), 25 counts of Penal Code Section 470(d) (Forgery), 14 counts of Penal Code Section 487(a)(Grand Theft), four counts of Penal Code Section 530.5(a)(Identity Theft), four counts of Penal Code Section 115(a)(Recording a False or Forged Instrument), and two counts of Penal Code Section 470(a)(Forgery), all with the enhancement of Penal Code Section 186.11(a)(2)(Aggravated White Collar Crime over \$500,000), all felonies. These crimes are substantially related to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

On or about April 20, 2012, in the Superior Court of California, County of Orange, in Case No. 11ZF0120, Respondent was convicted of violating two counts of Revenue and Taxation Code Section 19705(a)(1)(File False Tax Return), and eight counts of Revenue and Taxation Code Section 19706(Willful Failure to File or Make Fraudulent Tax Return), both felonies. These crimes are substantially related to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted, as described above, constitute cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Business & Professions Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

5.

California Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the department, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement of the case.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all the licenses and license rights of Respondent, SUSHAMA D. LOHIA, under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code), for the costs of investigation and enforcement as provided by law, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
