Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 10083.2(c), the Real Estate Commissioner may only remove an item from the Website if it has been posted for “no less than 10 years”. Since the discipline in Case No. H-1738 SA occurred over 10 years ago, it can be removed from the Website. However, the discipline in Case No. H-40893 LA has been posted for less than 10 years and cannot be removed.
