



DECLARATION

My name is CEDRIC TRONCOSO, and I am currently licensed as a real estate broker and/or have license rights with respect to said license. I am representing myself in this matter.

In lieu of proceeding in this matter in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Sections 11400 et seq., of the Government Code), I wish to voluntarily surrender my real estate license(s) issued by the Bureau of Real Estate ("Bureau"), pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10100.2.

1 I understand that by so voluntarily surrendering my
2 license(s), I may be relicensed as a broker or as a salesperson
3 only by petitioning for reinstatement pursuant to Section 11522
4 of the Government Code. I also understand that by so voluntarily
5 surrendering my license(s), I agree to the following:

6 1. The filing of this Declaration shall be deemed as
7 my petition for voluntary surrender.


8 2. It shall also be deemed to be an understanding and
9 agreement by me that I waive all rights I have to require the
10 Commissioner to prove the allegations contained in the Accusation
11 filed in this matter at a hearing held in accordance with the
12 provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code
13 Sections 11400 et seq.), and that I also waive other rights
14 afforded to me in connection with the hearing such as the right
15 to discovery, the right to present evidence in defense of the
16 allegations in the Accusation and the right to cross-examine
17 witnesses.

19 3. I further agree that upon acceptance by the
20 Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, all
21 affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Bureau in
22 this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance, and all
23 allegations contained in the Accusation filed in the Bureau, Case
24 No. H-38658 LA, may be considered by the Bureau to be true and
25 correct for the purpose of deciding whether to grant re-licensure
26 or reinstatement pursuant to Government Code Section 11522.
27

1 4. I freely and voluntarily surrender all my licenses
2 and license rights under the Real Estate Law.

3 5. A copy of the Commissioner's Criteria of
4 Rehabilitation is attached hereto. If and when a petition
5 application is made for reinstatement of a surrendered license,
6 the Real Estate Commissioner will consider as one of the criteria
7 of rehabilitation, whether or not restitution has been made to
8 any person who has suffered monetary losses through
9 "substantially related" acts or omissions of Respondent(s),
10 whether or not such persons are named in the Accusation filed in
11 this case.

12 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of
13 the State of California that the above is true and correct and
14 that this declaration was executed on July 8/12, 2013.



17 The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate
18 Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of Accusation
19 against CEDRIC TRONCOSO (hereafter "Respondent") is informed and
20 alleges as follows:

21 1.

22 The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate
23 Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation
24 in her official capacity.

1 Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license
2 rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the
3 Business and Professions Code, hereinafter "Code") as a real
4 estate broker.
5

6 3.

7 On or about August 9, 2012, in Case No. 10-O-06758,
8 Respondent was disbarred from the practice of law in California
9 by the California Supreme Court. Revocation was based on the
10 following misconduct which occurred in two client matters: (1)
11 Failure to pay client funds promptly (Rule 4-100(B)(4), Rules of
12 Professional Conduct); (2) Failure to maintain client funds in
13 trust account (Rule 4-100(A)); (3) Misappropriation (Code
14 Section 6106); (4) Misrepresentation to client (Code Section
15 6106); (5) Failure to cooperate in State Bar investigation (Code
16 Section 6068(i)); (6) Failure to maintain client funds in trust
17 account (Rule 4-100(A)); (7) Misappropriation (Code Section
18 6106); (8) Failure to obey a court order (Code Section 6103);
19 and (9) Seeking to mislead a judge (Code Section 6068(d)).


22 The acts resulting in the revocation of Respondent's
23 license to practice law in California, as is alleged herein
24 above in Paragraph 3, constitute cause under Sections 480(a)(3)
25 and/or 10177(f) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of
26 the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real
27 Estate Law.

1 Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that
2 in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding
3 before the department, the Commissioner may request the
4 administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have
5 committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed
6 the reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement of the
7 case.

8 WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be
9 conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon
10 proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary
11 action against all the licenses and license rights of Respondent
12 CEDRIC TRONCOSO under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4
13 of the Business and Professions Code), for the cost of
14 investigation and enforcement as permitted by Code Section
15 10106, and for such other and further relief as may be proper
16 under other applicable provisions of law.
