ACCUSATION

The Complainant, JOHN W. SWEFNEY, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of Accusation against LEROY JOSEPH LOUCHART (hereinafter "Respondent"), is informed and alleges as follows:

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Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) (hereafter "Code") as a real estate broker.

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The Complainant, JOHN W. SWEENEY, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation in his official capacity.

On or about October 23, 2002, in the Superior Court, County of Stanislaus, State of California, Respondent was convicted of a violation of 647.6 of the California Penal Code (Annoy or molest a child under the age of 18), a crime involving moral turpitude and/or a crime which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee.

IV

The facts alleged above constitute cause under Section 490 and/or Section 10177(b) of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

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WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code), and for such other and further relief as may be proper under the provisions of law.
