ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE

TO: MOISES CONTRERAS 3400 ROBIN WOOD STREET BAKERSFIELD, CA 93309

On December 4, 2006, Respondent was denied a real estate salesperson license, but was granted the right to a restricted real estate salesperson license, subject to the terms, conditions and restrictions set forth in the Real Estate Commissioner's Decision and Order filed November 13, 2006, and effective December 4, 2006, in Case No. H-1960 FR.

Among those terms, conditions and restrictions, the Real Estate Commissioner may by appropriate order suspend the right to exercise any privileges granted under the restricted license, in

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the event of "[t]he conviction of Respondent (including a plea of nolo contendere) of a crime which is substantially related to Respondent's fitness or capacity as a real estate licensee."

On or about June 27, 2017, in the Superior Court of California, County of Kern, Case No. BF164948A, Respondent was convicted on a plea of nolo contendere for violation of Penal Code section 273.5(a) (corporal injury resulting in a traumatic condition upon a spouse or cohabitant), a felony. This conviction bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to Respondent's fitness or capacity as a real estate licensee.

The Commissioner has determined that as of this felony conviction date of June 27, 2017, Respondent is in violation of the Commissioner's Order of November 6, 2006, and California Business and Professions Code ("Code") Section 10177(k).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of Section 10156.7 of the Code that the restricted real estate salesperson license heretofore issued to Respondent and the exercise of any privileges thereunder is hereby suspended until such time as Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Bureau of Real Estate ("Bureau") of compliance with the condition referred to above, or pending final determination made after a hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by the Bureau which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed, self-addressed envelope to:

HEARING RIGHTS: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions Code, you have the right to a hearing to contest the Commissioner's determination that you are in violation of the Order in Case No. H-1960 FR. If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed

to the Bureau of Real Estate, Attn: Judith B. Vasan at 320 W. 4th St., Ste. 350, Los Angeles, California, within 20 days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on you, the Bureau will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing.
