PROPOSED DECISION

This matter was presided over as an uncontested case by Randolph Brendia, Regional Manager, Department of Real Estate, as the designee of the Real Estate Commissioner, in Los Angeles, California on November 27, 1995.

James R. Peel, Counsel, represented the complainant.

No appearance was made by or on behalf of respondent DONALD JAY HESS. On proof of compliance with Government Code Section 11505, the matter proceeded as a default pursuant to Government Code Section 11520.

The following Decision is proposed, certified and recommended for adoption:

FINDINGS OF FACT

Ι

DONALD JAY HESS (hereinafter referred to as respondent) is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code, hereinafter Code).

At all times herein mentioned, respondent was licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the State of California as a real estate broker. Effective March 30, 1993, the real estate broker license of respondent was suspended as a result of the Decision in Case No. H-1457 SA.

Said suspension was stayed for 3 1/2 years subject to terms and conditions.

IV

Respondent, an attorney in the State of California, in State Bar Court Case Nos. 92-0-14063 and 92-0-14064, filed August 31, 1994, was suspended from the practice of law for a period of one year and until he makes restitution.

<u>DETERMINATION OF ISSUES</u>

Ι

The conduct of respondent, as found above, is grounds to suspend or revoke the license and license rights of respondent pursuant to Section 10177(f) of the Code.

II

The standard of proof applied at the hearing was clear and convincing proof to a reasonable certainty.

ORDER

All licenses and license rights of respondent DONALD JAY HESS under the provisions of Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code are revoked.
