ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE

On October 24, 2012, a restricted real estate broker license was issued by the Department of Real Estate to Respondent on the terms, conditions and restrictions set forth in the Real Estate Commissioner's Decision of July 1, 2012, in Case No. H-2499 FR. This Order, which was effective August 9, 2012, granted Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate broker license subject to the provisions of Section

10156.7 of the California Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code") and to enumerated additional terms, conditions and restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of said Code. Among those terms, conditions and restrictions, Respondent was required to provide proof satisfactory to the Real Estate Commissioner, within 6 months of the effective date of the Decision, of paying restitution as follows: \$10,287 to Ines Monguio, \$19,976 to Steve Benakovich, \$2,989 to Rafael Rosas, \$1,800 James P. Gentry, \$2,230 to Dan Larsen and \$2,300 to Josephine Brown. The Commissioner has determined that as of February 9, 2013, Respondent has failed to satisfy this condition, and as such, is in violation of Section 10177(k) of the Code. (Respondent has no right to renew the restricted license if this condition isn't satisfied by the date of its expiration. (Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions Code.)

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California that the restricted real estate broker license heretofore issued to Respondent and the exercise of any privileges there under is hereby suspended until such time as Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Department of compliance with the condition(s) referred to above, or pending final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below), or pending a subsequent agreement with the Department.

If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Department at Los Angeles, California, within 20 days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on you, the Department will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
