ORDER GRANTING REMOVAL OF DISCIPLINE INFORMATION FROM RESPONDENT'S PUBLIC INFORMATION PAGE ON THE DEPARTMENT OF REAL ESTATE'S WEBSITE

On April 29, 2011, in Case No. H-2594 FR, a Decision was rendered denying Respondent's real estate salesperson license application, but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license. A restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent on May 5, 2011.

On February 25, 2022, Respondent was granted the removal of restrictions attaching to Respondent's real estate salesperson license.

On May 25, 2021, Respondent petitioned for the removal of discipline information from Respondent's Public Information Page on the Department of Real Estate's Website ("the Website").

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of

law for the removal of discipline from the Website and that Respondent does not pose a credible risk to the public, and that it would not be against the public interest for removal of said discipline.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for removal of discipline information from the website is granted.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
