ORDER GRANTING REMOVAL OF DISCIPLINE INFORMATION FROM RESPONDENT'S
PUBLIC INFORMATION PAGE ON THE DEPARTMENT OF REAL ESTATE'S WEBSITE

On January 19, 2022, in Case No. H-2631 FR, a Decision was rendered disciplining the real estate salesperson license of Respondent effective February 20, 2012.

On December 27, 2022, Respondent was granted the reinstatement of Respondent's real estate salesperson license.

On September 26, 2022, Respondent petitioned for the removal of discipline information from Respondent's Public Information Page on the Department of Real Estate's Website ("the Website").

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent does not present a credible risk to the public and that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the removal of

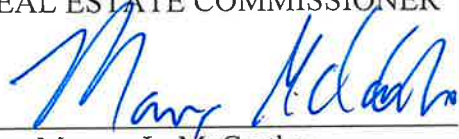
1 discipline from the Website and that it would not be against the public interest for removal of said
