ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSES

At all times mentioned herein since December 20, 2012, Respondent has been and is now licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code (Code) as real estate salesperson whose license was and now is restricted subject to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Code and to enumerated additional terms, conditions and restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of the Code.

On March 22, 2018, in Case No. H-3143 FR, an Accusation by a Supervising Special Investigator of the State of California was filed alleging cause under Sections 10177(d) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of Section 10156.7 of the Code of the State of California that any restricted real estate sales person license heretofore issued to Respondent, and the exercise of any privileges thereunder, is hereby suspended pending final determination made after the hearing on the aforesaid Accusation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by the Bureau of Real Estate which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed self-addressed envelope to:
