ORDER GRANTING REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS ON LICENSE

On July 29, 2002, in Case No. H-2737 SD, a Decision was rendered herein denying Respondent's application for a real estate salesperson license, but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license. A restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent on August 8, 2002. On October 26, 2006, in Case No. H-3555 SD, a Decision was rendered revoking the restricted real estate salesperson license of Respondent effective November 15, 2006, but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of another restricted real estate salesperson license. That restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent on November 15, 2016 and expired on November 14, 2010.

On July 1, 2021, Respondent petitioned for the removal of restrictions attaching to Respondent's real estate salesperson license.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support

thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate salesperson license and that it would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition the removal of restrictions attaching to Respondent's real estate salesperson license is granted and that a real estate salesperson license be issued to Respondent if Respondent satisfies the following requirements:

- 1. Qualify for, take and pass the real estate salesperson license examination.
- 2. Submit a completed application and pay the fee for a real estate salesperson license.
