California Penal Code (Receiving Stolen Goods), a felony and a crime that bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10 of the California Code of Regulations, (Regulations), to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

4.

On or about December 2, 2002 in the Superior Court of the State of Nevada, County of Washoe, Case No. CR 02-1981, Respondent was convicted of Grand Larceny, a felony and a crime that bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910 of the Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

On or about January 9, 2004, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Sacramento, Case No. 02F07999, Respondent was convicted of violating Section 666 of the California Penal Code (Burglary), a misdemeanor and a crime that bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910 of the Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

6.

Respondent's criminal convictions, as set out in Paragraphs 3 through 5, above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate salesperson license pursuant to the provisions of Sections 480(a) (Conviction of Crime) and 10177(b) (Further Grounds for Disciplinary Action-Conviction of Crime) of the Code.
