STATEMENT OF ISSUES

15 The Complainant, Ruben Coronado, a Supervising Special
16 Investigator I of the State of California, acting in his
17 official capacity, for Statement of Issues against MICHAEL
18 RANDALL STILL ("Respondent") alleges as follows:

1. 19

20 On or about October 17, 2012, Respondent made
21 application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of
22 California for a real estate salesperson license.

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(CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

2.

On or about October 10, 2001, in the Superior Court of California, County of Kern, Case No. BF095452A, Respondent was convicted of violating California Penal Code Section 261.5(c) (unlawful sexual intercourse with a minor), a felony. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

On or about September 21, 2007, in the Superior Court of California, County of Kern, Case No. BM710110A, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code Section 23103(a) (reckless driving), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted as alleged herein constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-

1 entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the
2 charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
3 authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real
4 estate salesperson license to Respondent, MICHAEL RANDALL STILL,
5 and for such other and further relief as may be proper under
6 other applicable provisions of law.
