## AMENDED ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On January 18, 1994, in Case No. H-2919 SAC a Decision was rendered revoking
the real estate salesperson license of Respondent effective February 16, 1994, but granting
Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license. A restricted
real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent on February 19, 1994, and Respondent
has held a restricted license since that time.

On July 18, 1996, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of Respondent's real estate salesperson license. The petition was granted; however, Respondent did not apply for the plenary license within 1 year from the Order and the term expired.

On December 12, 2022, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of Respondent's real estate salesperson license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support
thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements
