ORDER SUSPENDING REAL ESTATE LICENSE

TO: RICKY WILFREDO PORTILLO, Respondent 14304 Tierra Blanca Ave. Bakersfield, CA 93314

On August 7, 2019, Respondent's real estate salesperson license (DRE license ID 01824471) was revoked, but Respondent was granted the right to a restricted license, subject to the terms, conditions and restrictions set forth in the Decision filed July 19, 2019, in Case No. H-03230 FR. This Decision became effective at 12 o'clock noon on August 7, 2019.

 Among those terms, conditions and restrictions, the failure of which the Real Estate Commissioner may by appropriate order suspend the right to exercise any privileges granted under the restricted license is the requirement that:

"5. Respondent shall, within nine months from the effective date of this Decision, present evidence satisfactory to the Real Estate Commissioner that respondent has, since the most recent issuance of an original or renewal real estate license, taken and successfully completed the continuing education requirements of Article 2.5 of Chapter 3 of the Real Estate Law for renewal of a real estate license. If respondent fails to satisfy this condition, the Commissioner may order the suspension of the restricted license until the respondent presents such evidence. The Commissioner shall afford respondent the opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act to present such evidence."

The Commissioner has determined that as of August 5, 2021, Respondent has failed to satisfy this condition, and as such, is in violation of the Commissioner's Order of August 7, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of the Order issued in this matter that the real estate salesperson license heretofore issued to Respondent and the exercise of any privileges thereunder is hereby suspended until such time as Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Department of compliance with the condition referred to above, or pending final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by the Department which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed, self-addressed envelope to:

HEARING RIGHTS: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and

Professions Code, you have the right to a hearing to contest the Commissioner's determination that you are in violation of the Order in Case No. H-03230 FR. If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Department of Real Estate at 320 W. 4th Street, Suite 350, Los Angeles California, 90013, within twenty (20) days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on you, the Department will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing.

THIS ORDER SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
