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| 15 | The Complainant, Brenda Smith, a Supervising Special Investigator for the Department of |
| 16 | Real Estate ("Department") of the State of California, for cause of Accusation against |
| 17 | FERNANDO BOCANEGRA ("Respondent"), is informed and alleges in her official capacity as |
| - 18 | follows: |
| 19 | 1. The Complainant, Brenda Smith, acting in her official capacity as a Supervising |
| 20 | Special Investigator, makes this Accusation against Respondent. |
| 21 | 2. Respondent presently has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of |
| 22 | Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code ("Code"), as a real estate salesperson |
| 23 | (License ID 01700664). |
| 24 | FIRST CAUSE OF ACCUSATION |
| 25 | (CRIMINAL CONVICTION) |
| 26 | 3. On or about December 15, 2017, in the Superior Court of California, County of |
| 27 | Kern, Case No. BF169523A, Respondent was found guilty and convicted on a plea of nolo |
| 28 | contendere for violation of Penal Code section 243(d) (battery causing serious bodily injury), a |
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felony. The court found that Respondent's plea was entered on condition that he complete 12 months of Veteran's Affairs ("V.A.") counseling at a local and Los Angeles Veterans Center. The court suspended a two-year prison sentence pending Respondent's successful completion of V.A. counseling.

4. On or about January 7, 2019, the court held a veteran program proceeding based on
Penal Code section 1170.9. The court suspended the imposition of sentence and placed
Respondent on formal probation for 3 years, ordered Respondent to serve 1 day of jail time, with
credit for 1 day time served, and ordered Respondent to make restitution to the victim, pay
restitution to the restitution fund, and pay fees, fines, an assessment, and costs

5. The conviction, as described in Paragraphs 3 and 4 above, bears a substantial
relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the
qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

6. The crime, for which Respondent was convicted, as described in Paragraph 3
above, constitutes cause under Code sections 490 and 10177(b) for the suspension or revocation of
the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

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SECOND CAUSE OF ACCUSATION

(FAILURE TO REPORT CONVICTION)

7. Pursuant to Section 10186.2 of the Code, a licensee shall report, in writing, "the
conviction of the licensee, including any verdict of guilty, or plea of guilty or no contest, of any
felony or misdemeanor" to the Department within thirty (30) days of the conviction. Respondent
failed to report in writing to the Department the conviction described in Paragraphs 3 and 4 above,
within thirty (30) days of the conviction dates.

8. Respondent's failure to timely report the conviction constitutes cause under Section
10186.2 of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of
Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

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| 2 | (COSTS OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT) |
| 3 | 9. California Business and Professions Code section 10106, provides, in pertinent |
| 4 | part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Department of |
| 5 | Real Estate, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found |
| 6 | to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the |
| 7 | investigation and enforcement of the case. |
| 8 | WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this |
| 9 | Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action |
| 10 | against all the licenses and license rights of Respondent FERNANDO BOCANEGRA under the |
| 11 | Real Estate Law, for the costs of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for such |
| 12 | other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law. |
