DECISION

This Decision is being issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 11520 of the Government Code, on evidence of compliance with Section 11505 of the Government Code and pursuant to the Order of Default filed on February 10, 1998, and the findings of fact set forth herein, which are based on one or more of the following: (1) Respondent's express admissions; (2) affidavits; and (3) other evidence.

FINDINGS OF FACT

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On September 25, 1997, Charles W. Koenig made the Accusation in his official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California. The Accusation, Statement to Respondent, and Notice of Defense were mailed, by certified mail, to Respondent's last known mailing address on file with the Department on September 25, 1997.

On February 10, 1998, no Notice of Defense having been filed herein within the time prescribed by Section 11506 of the Government Code, Respondent's default was entered herein.

II

Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code") as a real estate broker licensee with the right to late renewal of said license.

III

On or about May 12, 1995, in the Superior Court, County of

Sacramento, State of California, in Case No. 95AS00203, a final judgment was entered against Respondent based on grounds of fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit with reference to a transaction for which a real estate license is required.

IV

On or about September 9, 1996, in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of California, in Case No. 92-2726, a final judgment was entered against Respondent based on grounds of fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit with reference to a transaction for which a real estate license is required.

PRIOR ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION

In Case No. H-1225 SAC, effective April 18, 1977, the Real Estate Commissioner denied the real estate salesperson license application of Respondent but granted Respondent the right to a restricted real estate salesperson license for a violation of Section 480(b) of the Code.

In Case No. H-1263 SAC, effective May 18, 1977, the Real Estate Commissioner denied the real estate broker license application of Respondent but granted Respondent the right to a restricted real estate broker license for a violation of Section 480(b) of the Code.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

Ι

Cause for disciplinary action against Respondent exists pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section <u>10177.5</u>.

II

The standard of proof applied was clear and convincing proof to a reasonable certainty.

<u>ORDER</u>

All licenses and licensing rights of respondent RUSSELL TERRY SCHAUER, under the provisions of Part I of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code are revoked.

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III 2 On or about May 12, 1995, in the Superior Court, County of Sacramento, State of California, in Case No. 95AS00203, a final 3 judgment was entered against Respondent based on grounds of fraud, 4 misrepresentation, or deceit with reference to a transaction for 5 6 which a real estate license is required. 7 IV 8 On or about September 9, 1996, in the United States 9 Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of California, in Case No. 92-2726, a final judgment was entered against Respondent based 10 on grounds of fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit with reference 11 12 to a transaction for which a real estate license is required. 13 14 The facts alleged above constitute cause under Section 10177.5 of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses 15 16 and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law. 17 PRIOR ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION 18 In Case No. H-1225 SAC, effective April 18, 1977, the 19 Real Estate Commissioner denied the real estate salesperson 20 license application of Respondent but granted Respondent the right 21 to a restricted real estate salesperson license for violations of 22 Sections 10177(a) and 10177(b) of the Code. 23 In Case No. H-1263 SAC, effective May 18, 1977, the 24 Real Estate Commissioner denied the real estate broker license 25 application of Respondent but granted Respondent the right to a restricted real estate broker license for violations of Sections 26 27 10177(a) and 10177(b) of the Code.
