17	On December 8, 2021, a Stipulation and Agreement was rendered in the above-
18	entitled matter, accepting the voluntary surrender of RED DOOR REALTY AND
19	MANAGEMENT, INC. and ordering that all licenses and licensing rights of JOHN FREDERICK
20	DEBETZ, II ("DEBETZ") are revoked; provided, however, a restricted real estate broker license is
21	issued to DEBETZ pursuant to the terms and conditions enumerated therein. The Order shall
22	become effective on January 7, 2022.
23	The Order states that all licenses and license rights of DEBETZ are suspended on
24	the effective date unless and until DEBETZ provides proof satisfactory to the Commissioner that
25 26	he has taken and successfully completed the continuing education course on Trust Fund
20	Accounting and Handling as specified in Section 10170.5(a)(3) of the Code. DEBETZ did not

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1	receive the Stipulation and Agreement until the afternoon of January 4, 2022, and therefore he
2	needs more time to complete the Trust Fund Accounting and Handling course.
3	Good cause having been shown, the time during which DEBETZ must take and
4	successfully complete the Trust Fund Accounting and Handling course is extended to February 7,
5	2022.
