GROUNDS FOR DENIAL

Respondent's criminal conviction described above in Paragraph 2 constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate salesperson license pursuant to the provisions of Sections 480(a)(1) (conviction of crime) and 10177(b) (conviction of crime) of the Business and Professions Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under applicable provisions of law.
