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ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR A REAL ESTATE LICENSE

The Real Estate Commissioner, in conformity with Section 10152, Division 4, Business and Professions Code of the State of California, required further proof of the honesty and truthfulness of RONALD REX HOMAN, SR. (hereinafter "Respondent"), in connection with Respondent's application for a real estate salesperson license filed on or about August 19, 2004, and in relation thereto, filed a Statement of Issues on March 3, 2006.

Said Statement of Issues was properly served on Respondent on or about May 5, 2006, and Respondent has, to date, failed to file a Notice of Defense, request a hearing, or otherwise establish that he is entitled to the license sought.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to the authority granted under Section 11520 of the Government Code of the State of California, that the application of RONALD REX HOMAN, SR., for a real estate salesperson license is hereby denied.

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Complainant, J. CHRIS GRAVES, a Deputy Real Estate

Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Statement of

Issues against Respondent in his official capacity.

ΙI

Respondent made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license on or about August 19, 2004, with the knowledge and

understanding that any license issued as a result of said application would be subject to the conditions of Section 10153.4 of the Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code").

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

III

On or about February 16, 1993, in the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, Respondent was convicted of two counts of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Drugs in violation of Vehicle Code Sections 23153a- 17b5 and 23153b- 17b5, misdemeanors and crimes involving moral turpitude that bear a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations (hereinafter "Regulations"), to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee.

IV

Respondent's criminal conviction, described in Paragraph III above, individually and collectively constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Sections 480(a) and 10177(b) of the Code.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

V

Respondent held Real Estate Broker License number 00379611, issued by the Department of Real Estate of the State of California, from on or about August 27, 1985, to on or about June 22, 1993.

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 On or about May 21, 1990, in Case No. H-24136 LA before the State of California Department of Real Estate, Respondent, as an individual and as designated officer of Approved Home Loan Corporation and Cal Vista Mortgage, was subject to an Order to Desist and Refrain issued pursuant to Section 10086 of the Code. This order prohibited Respondent from conducting activities requiring a real estate license and from receiving trust funds from others in connection with activities requiring a real estate license unless and until Respondent came into compliance with Sections 10232.2, 10232.25, 10232.4, and 10240(a) of the Code and Sections 2725(c), 2830, 2831, 2831.1, 2831.2, 2832.1, and 2834 of the Regulations.

VII

On or about June 22, 1993, in Case No. H-24960 LA before the State of California Department of Real Estate, Respondent's real estate broker license, described above, was revoked pursuant to Sections 10145, 10145(d), 10145(g), 10159.5, 10177(d), 10177(h), 10232.2, 10232.25, 10232.4, and 10240 of the Code, as well as Sections 2725, 2731, 2752, 2830, 2831, 2831.1, 2831.2, 2832.1, 2834, 2840, 2846.5, 2846.8, and 2950(h) of the Regulations.

VIII

The facts alleged in Paragraphs V, VI, and VII constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Sections 480(a)(3), 10177(d), 10177(f), 10177(g), and/or 10177(h) of the Code.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other provisions of law.
