1. All issues which were to be contested and all evidence which was to be presented by Complainant and Respondent at a formal hearing on the Order, which hearing was to be held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure

GREAT WESTERN BUSINESS SERVICES

Act (APA), shall instead and in place thereof be submitted solely on the basis of the provisions of this Stipulation and Agreement in Settlement.

- 2. Respondent filed a Request for Hearing pursuant to Section 10086 of the Business and Professions Code for the purpose of requesting a hearing on the allegations in the Order. Respondent hereby freely and voluntarily withdraws said Request for Hearing. Respondent acknowledges that it will thereby waive its right to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations in the Order at a contested hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the APA and that it will waive other rights afforded to it in connection with the hearing such as the right to present evidence in defense of the allegations in the Order and the right to cross-examine witnesses.
- 3. It is understood by the parties that the Real Estate Commissioner may adopt the Stipulation and Agreement as her decision in this matter. In the event that the Commissioner in her discretion does not adopt the Stipulation and Agreement in Settlement, it shall be void and of no effect, and Respondent shall retain the right to a hearing and proceeding on the Order under all the provisions of the APA and shall not be bound by any admission or waiver made herein.
- 4. The Order or any subsequent Order of the Real Estate Commissioner made pursuant to this Stipulation and Agreement in Settlement shall not constitute an estoppel, merger or bar to any further administrative or civil proceedings by the Department of Real Estate with respect to any matters which were

- 5. Respondent shall, within 90 days of the effective date of this Agreement:
 - a. Cause to be formed a corporation which may be known as Great Western Business ServicesCalifornia or a name substantially similar (GWBS-CA);
 - b. Apply for and obtain a California real estate
 broker license for GWBS-CA;
 - Desist and Refrain and any acts requiring a
 California real estate license will be
 performed by GWBS-CA and/or by California real
 estate brokers or salespersons licensed to and
 acting under the supervision of GWBS-CA; and
 - d. Insure that any advance fees within the

 meaning of Section 10026 of the Business and

 Professions Code (Code) are handled in

 accordance with Section 10146 of the Code and

 Sections 2970 and 2972 of Title 10, California

 Code of Regulations. Any materials used in

 obtaining advance fee agreements shall be

 submitted to the Department in accordance with

 Section 10085 of the Code.
- 6. The Department agrees that if Respondent performs the acts described in Paragraph 5 above, Respondent has complied

with the terms of the Order to Desist and Refrain filed in this matter. When Respondent has performed the acts described in Paragraph 5 above, Respondent will be deemed to be in compliance with the provisions of the Real Estate Law (Sections 10000 et seq. of the Code) and will not be ordered to Desist and Refrain from engaging in such acts on the grounds alleged in the Order to Desist and Refrain filed in this matter.
