STIPULATION AND WAIVER

Respondent

I, JAMIE SUE WRIGHT, respondent herein, do hereby affirm that I have applied to the Department of Real Estate for a real estate broker license and that to the best of my knowledge I have satisfied all of the statutory requirements for the issuance of the license, including the payment of the fee therefor.

I acknowledge that I have received and read the Statement of Issues and the Statement to Respondent filed by the Department of Real Estate on August 23, 2007, in connection with my application for a real estate broker license. I understand that the Real Estate Commissioner may hold a hearing on this Statement of Issues for the purpose of requiring further proof of my honesty and truthfulness and to prove other allegations therein, or that he may in his discretion waive the hearing and grant me a restricted real estate broker license based upon this Stipulation and Waiver. I also understand that by filing the Statement of Issues in this matter the Real Estate Commissioner is shifting the burden to me to make a satisfactory showing that I meet all the requirements for issuance of a real estate broker license. I further understand that by entering into this stipulation and waiver I will be stipulating that the Real Estate Commissioner has

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found that I have failed to make such a showing, thereby justifying the denial of the issuance to me of an unrestricted real estate broker license.

I hereby admit that the allegations of the Statement of Issues filed against me are true and correct and request that the Real Estate Commissioner in his discretion issue a restricted real estate broker license to me under the authority of Section 10156.5 of the Business and Professions Code.

I am aware that by signing this Stipulation and Waiver, and if this Stipulation and Waiver is accepted by the Real Estate Commissioner, I am waiving my right to a hearing and the opportunity to present evidence at the hearing to establish my rehabilitation in order to obtain an unrestricted real estate broker license. I am not waiving my right to a hearing and to further proceedings to obtain a restricted or unrestricted license if this Stipulation and Waiver is not accepted by the Commissioner.

I further understand that the following conditions, limitations, and restrictions will attach to a restricted license issued by the Department of Real Estate pursuant hereto:

- 1. The license shall not confer any property right in the privileges to be exercised and the Real

 Estate Commissioner may by appropriate order suspend the right to exercise any privileges
 granted under this restricted license in the event of:
 - a. The conviction of respondent (including a plea of nolo contendere) to a crime which bears a substantial relationship to respondent's fitness or capacity as a real estate licensee; or
 - b. The receipt of evidence that respondent has violated provisions of the California Real

 Estate Law, the Subdivided Lands Law, Regulations of the Real Estate Commissioner, or
 conditions attaching to this restricted license.
- 2. I shall not be eligible to apply for the issuance of an unrestricted real estate license nor the removal of any of the conditions, limitations, or restrictions attaching to the restricted license until two years have elapsed from the date of issuance of the restricted license to respondent.

Respondent can signify acceptance and approval of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation and Waiver by faxing a copy of the signature page, as actually signed by respondent, to the Department at fax number (916) 227-9458. Respondent agrees, acknowledges and understands that by electronically sending to the Department a fax copy of her actual signature as it appears on the Stipulation and Waiver, that receipt

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1	of the faxed copy by the Department shall be as binding on Respondent as if the Department had received
2	the original signed Stipulation and Waiver.

11	Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a restricted real estate broker license be issued to
12	respondent JAMIE SUE WRIGHT if respondent has otherwise fulfilled all of the statutory requirements for
13	licensure. The restricted license shall be limited, conditioned, and restricted as specified in the foregoing
14	Stipulation and Waiver.

STATEMENT OF ISSUES

The Complainant, PHILLIP IHDE, a Deputy Real Estate

Commissioner of the State of California, for Statement of Issues

against JAMIE SUE WRIGHT (hereinafter "Respondent"), is informed

and alleges as follows:

Ι

Respondent made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate broker license on or about October 21, 2006.

ΙI

Complainant, PHILLIP IHDE, a Deputy Real Estate

Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Statement of

Issues in his official capacity and not otherwise.

III

In response to Question 2 of said application, to wit: "Have you ever been convicted of any violation of law?", Respondent answered "No".

IV

On or about March 16, 1998, in the Superior Court,

County of San Luis Obispo, Respondent was convicted of a

violation of Section 14610(A)(1) of the California Vehicle Code

(Driving with a Suspended License), a crime involving moral

turpitude which bears a substantial relationship under Section

2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations, to the

qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee.

V

The crime of which Respondent was convicted, as alleged in Paragraph IV, constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Sections 480(a) and 10177(b) of the California Business and Professions Code.

VI

Respondent's failure to reveal the convictions set forth Paragraph IV in said application constitutes the procurement of a real estate license by fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or by making a material misstatement of fact in said application, which failure is cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Sections 480(c) and 10177(a) of the California Business and Professions Code.

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WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other provisions of law.
