ORDER EXTENDING TIME

On September 27, 2004, a Decision was rendered herein denying the application for a real estate salesperson license for CRAIG CLAYTON GILMORE ("Respondent"), but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license. A restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent on November 3, 2004, and Respondent has operated as a restricted licensee since that time.

On March 2, 2012, Respondent petitioned for the removal of restrictions attaching to Respondent's real estate salesperson license.

Effective March 12, 2013, an Order Granting Unrestricted License (Order) was signed granting the removal of the restrictions attaching to Respondent's real estate salesperson license providing Respondent satisfies the following requirements:

1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate salesperson license within the 12 month period following the date of the Order; and

1 2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education
2 requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education courses must be
3 completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed
4 application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of the Order.


5 Respondent submitted his application, the required fee and a completed
6 Continuing Education Course Verification form to apply for an unrestricted salesperson license
7 on February 27, 2014. However, the continuing education courses Respondent entered on the
8 Continuing Education Course Verification form that Respondent believed were acceptable to
9 meet the requirements of the Order were not completed within the 12 month period preceding
10 the date Respondent submitted his application, and therefore could not be used to satisfy the
11 conditions in Respondent's petition Order

12 Good cause having been shown, the time during which Respondent must submit
13 evidence of completion of the continuing education requirements is hereby extended for a
14 period of ninety (90) days from March 12, 2014, to June 10, 2014.

15 This Order shall be effective immediately.
