ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE

On September 12, 2012, a restricted real estate salesperson license was issued by the Bureau of Real Estate to BENJAMIN RENE WILLIAMS ("Respondent") on the terms, conditions, and restrictions set forth in the Real Estate Commissioner's Order of July 13, 2012, in Case No. H-04233 SD.

The Decision granted a restricted real estate salesperson

The Decision granted a restricted real estate salesperson license subject to terms, conditions, and restrictions, including but not limited to the following:

Respondent shall, within (9) months from the effective date of this Decision, present evidence satisfactory to the Commissioner that Respondent has, since the most recent issuance of an original or renewal restricted real estate license, taken and successfully completed the continuing education requirements of Article 2.5 of Chapter 3 of the Real Estate Law for renewal of a real estate license. Respondent fails to satisfy this condition, the Commissioner may order the suspension of the restricted license until the Respondent presents such evidence. The Commissioner shall afford Respondent the opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act to present such evidence.

The Order became effective on August 15, 2012, and Respondent was issued a restricted real estate salesperson license on September 12, 2012. However, as of June 17, 2013, Respondent has failed to provide evidence that he took and completed continuing education requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of California Business and Professions Code Section 10156.7 that Respondent's restricted real estate salesperson license and the exercise of any privileges thereunder are hereby suspended until Respondent enters into an agreement satisfactory to the Commissioner to provide such proof or a decision providing otherwise is adopted following a hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by the Bureau of Real Estate which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed self-addressed envelope to:
