## ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On May 9, 2013, in Case No. H-04325 SD, a Decision was rendered revoking the real estate broker license of Respondent SALLY ANN RAYMOND effective May 28, 2013.

On June 16, 2015, Respondent SALLY ANN RAYMOND petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate broker license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondent SALLY ANN RAYMOND's petition and the evidence in support thereof. Respondent SALLY ANN RAYMOND has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent SALLY ANN RAYMOND meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate broker license and that it would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent SALLY ANN RAYMOND.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent SALLY ANN

RAYMOND's petition for reinstatement is granted and that a real estate broker license be issued to Respondent SALLY ANN RAYMOND if Respondent satisfies the following requirements:

- 1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate broker license within the 12 month period following the date of this Order; and
- 2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education courses must be completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
