STATEMENT OF ISSUES

The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for Statement of Issues against AMY L. MAXWELL-CAMERON, a.k.a. Amy Carlson, Amy Lynn Maxwell-Cameron, Amy Maxwell, Amy Lynn Maxwell ("Respondent") alleges as follows:

1.

The Complainant makes this Statement of Issues against Respondent in her official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California.

2.

On or about October 17, 2012, Respondent made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license.

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On or about November 7, 2007 in the Superior Court of the State of Arizona, in and for the County of Pima, Case No. CR20050925, Respondent was convicted of violation of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") Sections 13-1103(A)(1) and (B) (manslaughter), a felony, and violation of A.R.S. 13-603 (authorized disposition of offenders), a felony; violation of A.R.S. 13-701 (sentence of imprisonment for a felony), a felony; violation of A.R.S. 13-702 (first time felony offenders), a felony; violation of A.R.S. 13-801 (fines for felonies), a felony; violation of A.R.S. 13-804 (reimbursement of incarceration costs), a felony; and violation A.R.S. 13-811 (disposition of fines), a felony.

4.

These crimes bear a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

5.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted as alleged in Paragraph 2 constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code. 1// /// 1// /// 1// 1// 1// 1// 1// /// ///

wherefore, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the

under other applicable provisions of law.
