- The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, acting in her 1. official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation against SIMCAL PROPERTIES, INC., and JAMES WILSON ROWE.
- SIMCAL PROPERTIES, INC., and JAMES WILSON ROWE 2. individually and as designated officer of Simcal Properties, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Respondents") are presently licensed and/or have license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code, hereinafter Code).
- At all times herein mentioned, Respondents SIMCAL PROPERTIES, INC., and JAMES WILSON ROWE were licensed as a real estate brokers. Respondent ROWE was the designated officer and pursuant to Code Section 10159.2 was responsible for the supervision and control of the activities conducted on behalf of the corporation by its officers and employees as necessary to secure full compliance with the provisions of the real estate law including supervision of salespersons licensed to the corporation in the performance of acts for which a real estate license is required.
- At all times material herein, Respondents engaged in the business of, acted in the capacity of, advertised or assumed to act as real estate brokers in the State of California within the meaning of Section 10131(b) of the Code including soliciting owners and renters, negotiating the lease and rental of real property, and collecting rents from real property.

- 6. The examination described in Paragraph 5, above, determined that, in connection with the activities described in Paragraph 4 above, Respondents accepted or received funds, including funds in trust (hereinafter "trust funds") from or on behalf of principals, and thereafter made deposit or disbursement of such funds.
- 7. In the course of activities described in Paragraphs 4 through 6 and during the examination period described in Paragraph 5, Respondents SIMCAL PROPERTIES, INC., and JAMES WILSON ROWE acted in violation of the Code and the Regulations as follows, and as more specifically set forth in Audit Report No. SD 130019 and related exhibits:
- a. Violated Code Section 10145 and Regulation 2832.1 by maintaining as of March 31, 2014 a trust account shortage of \$7,328.02.
- b. Violated Code Section 10145 and Regulation 2832 by collecting trust funds in the form of rent receipts and failing to place said funds into a trust account within three business days following receipt of funds.

c. Violated Code Section 10145 and Regulation 2831 by failing to maintain a control record that was accurate and complete for each trust account.

- d. Violated Code Section 10145 and Regulation 2831.1 by failing to maintain separate records for each beneficiary or property.
- e. Violated Code Section 10145 and Regulation 2831.2 by not maintaining complete and accurate monthly reconciliations of all the separate records to the control record.
- f. Violated Code Section 10148 by failing to provide books, records and documents requested by the bureau for examination and review.
- 8. The conduct, acts and/or omissions of Respondents SIMCAL PROPERTIES, INC., and JAMES WILSON ROWE, as alleged above, subjects their real estate licenses and license rights to suspension or revocation pursuant to Sections 10177(d) and 10177(g) of the Code.

## FAILURE TO SUPERVISE

9. The conduct, acts and/or omissions of Respondent ROWE, in failing to ensure full compliance with the Real Estate Law is in violation of Code Section 10159.2 and subjects his real estate licenses and license rights to suspension or revocation pursuant to Sections 10177(d), 10177(g), and 10177(h) of the Code.

## COST RECOVERY

Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the bureau, the commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondents SIMCAL PROPERTIES, INC., and JAMES WILSON ROWE individually and as designated officer of Simcal Properties, Inc. under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code), for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
