FIRST CAUSE FOR DENIAL (CRIMINAL CONVICTION)

3.

On or about May 15, 2001, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of Orange, Case No. 01CM01901, for violation of California Penal Code Section 487(a) (Grand Theft), a misdemeanor. Respondent was placed on three years of informal probation, and ordered to serve 30 days in jail and pay restitution, fines and fees.

4.

The conduct underlying the conviction described in Paragraph 3 is an act which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

5.

The conduct underlying the conviction described in Paragraph 3 above involves dishonesty, fraud, or deceit, which constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(3), 480(a)(2), and 10177(j).

SECOND CAUSE FOR DENIAL

(FAILURE TO REVEAL CONVICTION ON LICENSE APPLICATION)

In response to Part D, Question 1, under the Background Information section of his license application, to wit, "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF THE LAW? ALL STATE AND FEDERAL MISDEMEANOR AND FELONY CONVICTIONS, AND ALL MILITARY AND FOREIGN CONVICTIONS, MUST BE DISCLOSED. CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.4 OR A SIMILAR STATUTE MUST STILL BE DISCLOSED," Respondent answered "YES," but failed to disclose the conviction described in Paragraph 3 above.

Respondent's failure to reveal this conviction, as set forth in Paragraph 3 above, in his license application constitutes an attempt to procure a real estate license by fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or by making a false statement of material fact required to be revealed in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under California Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(1), 480(d), and 10177(a).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100,

Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to Respondent STEVEN THOMAS BUGIEL and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
