- 3. Respondent was licensed by the Bureau of Real Estate of the State of California as a real estate broker effective July 11, 2008. The license expired July 10, 2016. There is a two year right to renew.
- 4. On or about March 11, 2016, in the US District Court, Southern District of California, case No. 14-cr-2704-BEN, Respondent was convicted of violating Title 18:371 (conspiracy to commit bank bribery), a felony.
- 5. The above referenced matter bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee, Title 10, Chapter 6, Section 2910, California Administrative Code.
- 6. Respondent's conviction alleged in Paragraph 4 is cause under Code Sections 490 and 10177(b) for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action on the license and license rights of Respondent JACK EVAN PROBER, for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
