I understand that by so voluntarily surrendering MSI's license, MSI may be relicensed as a corporate broker, or issued a new mortgage loan originator endorsement, only by petitioning for reinstatement pursuant to Section 11522 of the Government Code. I also understand that by so voluntarily surrendering its license, MSI and I agree to the following:

- 1. The filing of this Declaration shall be deemed as MSI's petition for voluntary
- 2. It shall also be deemed to be an understanding and agreement by MSI that it waives all rights it has to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations contained in the Accusation and filed in this matter at a hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code sections 11400 et seq.), and that MSI also waives other rights afforded to it in connection with the hearing such as the right to discovery, the right to present evidence in defense of the allegations in the Accusation and the right to cross-examine witnesses.
- 3. MSI further agrees that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, all affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Department in this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance, and all allegations contained in the pleadings filed in the Department case number H-04988 SD, may be considered by the Department to be true and correct for the purpose of deciding whether to grant relicensure or reinstatement pursuant to Government Code section 11522.
