FIRST CAUSE OF ACCUSATION

(CRIMINAL CONVICTION)

3.

On or about November 17, 2016, in the Superior Court of California, County of Imperial, Case No. JCF35819, Respondent was convicted on a plea of no contest for violation of Penal Code section 273.5(a) (corporal injury to a spouse or cohabitant), a felony. Respondent was placed on formal probation for 3 years subject to certain terms and conditions, including in part, serving 1 day in county jail with credit, performing 100 hours of community service work, participating in a 52 week certified anger management counseling/education program, and participating in an alcohol counseling/educational program.

4.

The conviction, as described in Paragraph 3 above, bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

5.

The crime of which Respondent was convicted, as described in Paragraph 3 above, constitutes cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACCUSATION (FAILURE TO REPORT CONVICTION)

6.

Pursuant to Section 10186.2 of the Code, a licensee shall report, in writing, "the conviction of the licensee, including any verdict of guilty, or plea of guilty or no contest, of any felony or misdemeanor" to the Department of Real Estate ("Department") within thirty (30) days of the conviction. Respondent failed to report in writing to the Bureau the conviction described in Paragraph 3 above, within thirty (30) days of the conviction date.

Respondent's failure to timely report the convictions constitutes cause under Section 10186.2 of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

(COSTS OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT)

California Business and Professions Code section 10106, provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau of Real Estate, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.
