STIPULATION

AND

AGREEMENT

It is hereby stipulated by and between Respondent DANIEL RODRIGUEZ ("Respondent"), Complainant, acting by and through Andrea Bentler, Counsel for the Department of Real Estate, as follows for the purpose of settling and disposing of the Accusation ("Accusation") filed on August 23, 2018, in this matter:

- 1. All issues which were to be contested and all evidence which was to be presented by Complainant and Respondent at a formal hearing on the Accusation, which hearing was to be held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act ("APA"), shall instead and in place thereof be submitted solely on the basis of the provisions of this Stipulation and Agreement ("Stipulation").
- Respondent has received, read and understands the Statement to Respondent, the Discovery Provisions of the APA and the Accusation filed by the Department of Real Estate in this proceeding.
 - 3. Respondent filed a Notice of Defense pursuant to Section 11506 of the

Government Code for the purpose of requesting a hearing on the allegations in the Accusation.

Respondent hereby freely and voluntarily withdraws said Notice of Defense. Respondent

acknowledges that he understands that by withdrawing said Notice of Defense he thereby waives

his right to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations in the Accusation at a contested

hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the APA and that he will waive other rights

afforded to him in connection with the hearing such as the right to present evidence in his

defense, and the right to cross-examine witnesses.

- 4. This Stipulation is based on the factual allegations contained in the Accusation. In the interest of expedience and economy Respondent chooses not to contest these allegations but to remain silent and understand that, as a result thereof, these factual allegations, without being admitted or denied, will serve as a prima facie basis for the disciplinary action stipulated to herein. The Real Estate Commissioner shall not be required to provide evidence to prove said factual allegations.
- 5. This Stipulation is made for the purpose of reaching an agreed disposition of this proceeding and is expressly limited to this proceeding and not any other proceeding or case in which the Department of Real Estate ("Department"), or another licensing agency of this state, another state, or the federal government is involved, and otherwise shall not be admissible in any criminal or civil proceeding.
- 6. It is understood by the parties that the Real Estate Commissioner may adopt this Stipulation as his Decision in this matter thereby imposing the penalty and sanctions on Respondent's real estate licenses and license rights as set forth in the below "Order." In the event that the Commissioner in his discretion does not adopt the Stipulation, the Stipulation shall be void and of no effect and Respondent shall retain the right to a hearing and proceed on the Accusation under the provisions of the APA and shall not be bound by any stipulation or waiver made herein.
- 7. The Order or any subsequent Order of the Real Estate Commissioner made pursuant to this Stipulation shall not constitute an estoppel, merger or bar to any further

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administrative or civil proceedings by the Department of Real Estate with respect to any matters which were not specifically alleged to be causes for accusation in this proceeding.

8. Respondent understands that by agreeing to this Stipulation, Respondent agrees to pay, pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10106, the cost of the investigation of this matter. The amount of said cost is \$314.50.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

By reason of the foregoing, it is stipulated and agreed that the following determination of issues shall be made:

The conduct, acts or omissions of DANIEL RODRIGUEZ, as described in Paragraph 4, above, are a basis for discipline of Respondent's license and license rights as a violation of the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code ("Code"), pursuant to Code Section 10177(b).

ORDER

WHEREFORE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER is hereby made:

All licenses and licensed rights of Respondent DANIEL RODRIGUEZ under the Real Estate Law are revoked; provided, however, a restricted real estate salesperson license shall be issued to Respondent pursuant to Section 10156.5 of the Business and Professions Code if Respondent makes application therefor and pays to the Department of Real Estate the appropriate fee for the restricted license within 90 days from the effective date of this Decision. The restricted license issued to Respondent shall be subject to all of the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions Code and to the following limitations, conditions and restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of that Code:

1. The restricted license issued to Respondent may be suspended prior to hearing by Order of the Real Estate Commissioner in the event of either Respondent's conviction or plea of nolo contendere to a crime which is substantially related to Respondent's fitness or capacity as a real estate licensee.

- 2. The restricted license issued to Respondent may be suspended prior to hearing by Order of the Real Estate Commissioner on evidence satisfactory to the Commissioner that Respondent has violated provisions of the California Real Estate Law, the Subdivided Lands Law, Regulations of the Real Estate Commissioner or conditions attaching to the restricted license.
- 3. Respondent shall not be eligible to petition for the issuance of any unrestricted real estate licenses nor for removal of any of the conditions, limitations or restrictions of a restricted license until two (2) years have elapsed from the effective date of this Decision and Order. Respondent shall not be eligible to apply for any unrestricted licenses until all restrictions attaching to the license have been removed.
- 4. Respondent shall submit with any application for license under an employing broker, or any application for transfer to a new employing broker, a statement signed by the prospective employing real estate broker on a form approved by the Department of Real Estate which shall certify:
- (a) That the employing broker has read the Decision of the Commissioner which granted the right to a restricted license; and
- (b) That the employing broker will exercise close supervision over the performance by the restricted licensee relating to activities for which a real estate license is required.
- 5. Respondent shall notify the Commissioner in writing within 72 hours of any arrest by sending a certified letter to the Commissioner at Department of Real Estate, Post Office Box 137013, Sacramento, CA 95813-7013. The letter shall set forth the date of Respondent's arrest, the crime for which Respondent was arrested, and the name and address of the arresting law enforcement agency. Respondent's failure to timely file written notice shall constitute an independent violation of the terms of the restricted license and shall be grounds for the suspension or revocation of that license.

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1	6. Prior to the effective date of this Decision, and pursuant to Section 10106 of
2	the Business and Professions Code, Respondent shall pay the Commissioner's reasonable cost
3	for the investigation which led to this disciplinary action in the amount of \$314.50. Said paymen
4	shall be in the form of a cashier's check made payable to the Department of Real Estate. Said
5	check must be delivered to the Department of Real Estate, Flag Section, P.O. Box 137013,
6	Sacramento, CA 95813-7013, prior to the effective date of this Decision and Order. If
7	Respondent fails to satisfy this condition in a timely manner as provided for herein,
8	Respondent's real estate license shall automatically be suspended until payment is made in full,
9	or until a decision providing otherwise is adopted following a hearing held pursuant to this
10	condition.
