The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, a Supervising Special Investigator of the State of California, for cause of Accusation against ROBERTO WILLIAM POLLORENA ("Respondent"), is informed and alleges as follows:

1.

The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, acting in her official capacity as a Supervising Special Investigator of the State of California, makes this Accusation against ROBERTO WILLIAM POLLORENA.

2.

Respondent presently has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code ("Code"), as a real estate salesperson. Respondent also has an individual mortgage loan originator license endorsement.

Accusation of Roberto William Pollorena

On or about September 25, 2016, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, Case No. C362704, for violation of California Vehicle Code section 23103(a) (Reckless Driving), a misdemeanor. Respondent was placed on three years of summary probation, and ordered to pay fines and fees. Additionally, Respondent was ordered to complete 13 days of Public Service Program, MADD Program, and a 3 month First Conviction Program.

4.

In aggravation, on or about March 17, 2017, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, Case No. M217622, for violation of California Penal Code section 242 (Battery), a misdemeanor.

5.

On or about June 4, 2018, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, Case No. SCD272827, for violation of California Penal Code section 422 (Criminal Threats), a felony, with enhancement under Penal Code sections 1192.7(c)(23), 12022(b)(1), and 1203(e)(2). Respondent was placed on five years of formal probation, and ordered to serve 270 days in jail and pay restitution, fines and fees.

6.

The convictions described in Paragraphs 3 and 5 bear a substantial relationship under section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

7.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted, as described in Paragraphs 3 and 5 above, constitute cause under sections 490 and 10177(b)(1) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of all the licenses, license endorsements, and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.
