17	State of California, for cause of Accusation against SUN YU KIM ("Respondent") alleges as
18	follows:

20	The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, a Supervising Special Investigator of the
21	State of California, makes this Accusation in her official capacity.

23	All references to the "Code" are to the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of
24	the California Business and Professions Code and all references to "Regulations" are to Title
25	10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

LICENSE HISTORY

3.

a. Respondent SUN YU KIM ("KIM") is presently licensed and/or has license
rights under the Code, as a real estate salesperson, Department of Real Estate ¹ ("Department")
icense ID 01486467.

- b. The Department originally issued Respondent KIM a salesperson license on May 9, 2005. Respondent's license is scheduled to expire May 8, 2021, unless renewed.
- c. Since February 8, 2019, Respondent KIM's employing broker is Coldwell Banker Residential Brokerage Company in Irvine, California.
- d. From on or about April 10, 2017, through February 7, 2019, KIM was not employed by a real estate broker.
- e. From December 29, 2016, through April 9, 2017, Respondent was employed by real estate broker Crystal Soojung Lee.
- f. From August 16, 2016, through December 28, 2017, Respondent was employed by real estate broker Craig Townsend doing business as Rancho Mesa Properties.
- g. From June 11, 2013, through August 15, 2016, Respondent was employed by the Answer Funding Inc. doing business as Wi Finance.
- h. According to the Department's records to date, KIM has not held a Mortgage Loan Originator endorsement with the Department.

CAUSE FOR ACCUSATION

4.

From on or about April 2016, through February 2018, while not endorsed to act as a mortgage loan originator, Respondent engaged in the business of, acted in the capacity of, advertised or assumed to act as a mortgage loan originator, within the meaning of Code section 10166.01.

¹ Between July 1, 2013 and July 1, 2018, the Department of Real Estate operated as the Bureau of Real Estate under the Department of Consumer Affairs.

In or about February 2018, while not employed by or licensed as a real estate broker, Respondent engaged in the business of, acted in the capacity of, advertised, or assumed to act as a real estate broker within the meaning of Code section 10131(d), for or in expectation of compensation, by soliciting borrowers or lenders for or negotiating loans or performing services for borrowers or lenders in connection with loans secured directly or collaterally by liens on real property (mortgage loan origination).

6.

In the April 2016 edition of the Korean-American Magazine Hanin News, Respondent placed an advertisement with her photo, Department license ID, and stated "NMLS: 310166." This number does not exist in the NMLS registry. In addition, Respondent's advertisement stated "Wi Finance," "25 years of experience in San Diego," "commercial, SBA, mortgage, refinancing, 3.5% FHA," and had a stamp that stated "Loan Approved."

7.

While not employed with any real estate broker nor endorsed to act as a mortgage loan originator, Respondent advertised in two different Korean-American magazines for their February 2018 issue. In the Hanin News magazine, Respondent's advertisement showed a logo for "Expert Lending" and it stated in Korean "commercial, SBA, mortgage, refinancing, 3.5% FHA" and "Interest rate has dropped again. Now is a good chance for refinancing. Please contact me." In the San Diego Korean American Community Magazine, Respondent's advertisement stated "Commercial Loan," "Home Loan", "SBA", and "FHA Loan (3.5%)" and "Expert Lending 7550 Degget St. #207, San Diego, CA 92111."

(UNLICENSED ACTIVITY)

8.

At all times mentioned in Paragraph 7, Respondent licensed by the Department as a real estate salesperson not employed by a licensed real estate broker. Respondent

conducted the real estate activities alleged above in Paragraph 7, while not employed by a 1 licensed real estate broker in violation of Code sections 10130 and 10131(d). 2 3 (SUBSTANTIAL MISREPRESENTATION) 4 9. 5 The conduct, acts and/or omissions of Respondent KIM, as described in б Paragraphs 4 through 7 above, constitute cause for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under Code section 10176(a), for making a substantial 7 8 misrepresentation. 9 (ADVERTISEMENT OF A MATERIAL FALSE STATEMENT) 10 10. The conduct, acts and/or omissions of Respondent KIM, as described in 11 Paragraphs 4 through 7 above, constitute cause for the suspension or revocation of the license 12 and license rights of Respondent under Code section 10177(c), knowingly authorizing the 13 publication, advertisement, distribution, or circulation of a material false statement or 14 15 representation concerning her designation. (WILLFUL DISREGARD OF THE REAL ESTATE LAW) 16 17 11. 18 The conduct, acts and/or omissions of Respondent KIM, as described in Paragraphs 4 through 7 above, constitute cause for the suspension or revocation of the license 19 and license rights of Respondent under Code section 10177(d), for willful disregard of the Real 20 Estate Law. (NEGLIGENCE AND/OR INCOMPETENCE) 12.

The conduct, acts and/or omissions of Respondent KIM, as described in Paragraphs 4 through 7 above, constitute cause for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under Code section 10177(g), for negligence and/or incompetence.

INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT COSTS

13.

Section 10106 of the Code, provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Department, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement of the case.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all the licenses and/or license rights of Respondent SUN YU KIM under the Real Estate Law, for the costs of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, for the cost of the audit, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
