14	ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE
15	On June 23, 2009, in Case No. H-5178 SAC, a Decision was rendered revoking
16	the real estate broker license of Respondent effective July 21, 2009, but granting Respondent the
17	right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license. A restricted real estate
18	salesperson license was issued to Respondent on July 21, 2009, and Respondent's license
19	expired on July 20, 2013.
20	On April 6, 2015, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of Respondent's real
21	estate broker license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of
22	the filing of the petition.
23	I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support
24	thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements
25	of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate broker license and that it
26	would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for
2	reinstatement is granted and that a real estate broker license be issued to Respondent if
3	Respondent satisfies the following requirements:
4	1. Qualify for, take and pass the real estate broker license examination.
5	2. Submit a completed application and pay the fee for a real estate broker
6	license.
7	If Respondent fails to meet the above requirements, and those of sections 10150.6,
8	10153 and 10153.2 of the California Business & Professions Code, to qualify for the issuance of
9	a real estate broker license, Respondent may be issued a real estate salesperson license if
10	Respondent qualifies for, takes and passes the examination for a real estate salesperson license,
11	submits a completed application and pays the required fee for a salesperson license within the 12
12	month period following the date of this order, and meets all of the other requirements for issuance
13	of a real estate salesperson license, including but not limited to section 10151 of the California
14	Business & Professions Code.
15	This Order shall become effective immediately.
