On or about January 21, 2011, Respondent made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California (herein "the Department") for a real estate salesperson license.

On or about October 15, 2009, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Sacramento, Case Number 2009172684, Respondent was convicted of violating section 14601.2(a) of the Vehicle Code (driving on a suspended or revoked license), a misdemeanor which bears a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10, California

Code of Regulations (herein "the Regulations") to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

On or about July 6, 2007, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Sacramento, Case Number 07T03062, Respondent was convicted of violating section 23152(b) of the Vehicle Code (driving with a blood alcohol level at or above .08%), a misdemeanor which bears a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10 of the Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

4.

On or about February 26, 2003, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Sacramento, Case Number 02T05022, Respondent was convicted of violating Vehicle Code sections 23152(a) (driving while under the influence of alcohol or drugs) and 14601.2(a) (driving on a suspended or revoked license), misdemeanors which bear a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10 of the Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

On or about January 13, 2000, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Sacramento, Case Number 00T00113, Respondent was convicted of violating section 23152(b) of the Vehicle Code (driving with a blood alcohol level at or above .08 %), a misdemeanor which bears a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10 of the Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

On or about August 19, 1996, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Placer, Case Number R-42269, Respondent was convicted of violating section 23152(a) of the Vehicle Code (driving while under the influence of alcohol or drugs), a misdemeanor which bears a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10 of the Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

1 2 On or about February 20, 1996, in the Superior Court of the State of California, 3 County of Placer, Case Number A-35662, Respondent was convicted of violating section 4 148.9(a) of the Penal Code (providing false information to a police officer), a misdemeanor 5 which bears a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10 of the Regulations to the 6 qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee. 7 8. 8 Respondent's criminal convictions, as described above in Paragraphs 2 through

7, constitute grounds under sections 480(a) and 10177(b) of the Code for the denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate broker license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
